Homes and Businesses may have been badly affected in Herefordshire by the recent flooding. The Government has announced a support package but in order to get the support on offer we have to detail the damage that has been caused. Time to apply for the support is incredibly short (we need the info by 3pm tomorrow). Any help you can give to spread the word and get people to e-mail in to us, would be most appreciated. The info we need is as follows:-

Flooded homes

We would like to hear urgently from people whose homes have been affected by flooding.

Our initial assessment has been that mercifully few homes in Herefordshire have been flooded in the recent poor weather. We are aware than not everyone who has been flooded may have contacted the emergency services or the council for help.

Your home may have been affected by flooding in one of a number of ways: water may have entered your home, you may have been trapped in your home or other parts of your property or outbuildings may have flooded.

Central government has announced a grant scheme to help householders "repair and renew" after flooding. The details are still being finalised.

We need to report to government on Wednesday on how many homes are affected in Herefordshire. In order to be included in this report we will need to hear from householders by 3pm on Wednesday 19 February 2014.

Even after that date we would still like you to let us know if you have been affected by flooding.

We would like to hear from any Herefordshire small or medium-sized businesses that have been affected by flooding.

Central government announced yesterday (17th February) that hardship funding will be made available to small and medium sized enterprises who need help to develop and implement recovery plans.

A range of costs may be covered

Eligible businesses will be able to claim for costs which could include immediate clean-up costs, materials, exceptional business costs (such as hire of drying equipment) and temporary accommodation to enable them to continue trading.

Business continuity planning and marketing costs may also be covered.

Details are still emerging
