Crimes and incidents of interest 1st May– 30th May 2015

Fownhope

2nd May at approx 16:15hrs. Non-stop vehicle collision. An unknown vehicle, possibly black in colour has driven passed victims Honda Civic, causing wing mirror and side window to smash. No further details at this time.

Credenhill

Between the hours of 15:30 on the 6th and 06:00hrs on the 7th May - white transit van had its window smashed, a Stihl hedge cutter and disc cutter was taken from inside the vehicle.

Holmer

Between the 4th and 8th May, theft of Cube road bike, green/white in colour from the Furlongs residential area.

Police are asking for any information regarding 2 to 3 males seen in the fields off Attwood Lane and the rear of the Furlongs estate, carrying/firing air rifles. Times seen are usually 07:00-08:00 and 17:00-18:00. If seen, please report at the time.

Breinton

Report from local farmer of 2 males riding unauthorised motorbikes along farmland. The use of these vehicles, including pit bikes, moto-cross bikes and mini-motos is a growing trend. Whilst the use of them brings enjoyment to some, they often cause annoyance to others and can place people at risk. It can also disrupt the quality of life of others at homes nearby or during leisure activity such as horse riding and dog walking. The vehicles can also cause considerable and permanent damage to the land. If the use of such vehicles is seen or heard please contact police with as much detail as possible. SNT have received similar reports of unauthorised vehicle use in areas of Credenhill, Withington and Bishopstone this month.

Wellington
