The following crimes and incidents may be of interest to your local parish area. Written in order of receipt from 1st July – 31st July 2015

BREINTON

1st July – Reported theft of 3 handbags from vehicle parked by Breinton Springs between 12:58 and 13:13.

FOWNHOPE

2nd July – person/s unknown have approached 2 buildings situated next to the pavilion on the Fownhope recreational field and forced the doors open. The wooden door to one of the buildings was locked with a mortice lock; this has been jemmed open causing damage to the door. The second building is a metal clad shed. Offender/s have cut the padlock off the door. Nothing reported stolen at this time.

HAMPTON BISHOP

2nd July. Reported theft of fishing equipment. At 22:50 victim left a Drenan fishing holdall along with 3 rods next to their vehicle which was parked unattended for 4-5 minutes near to The Bunch of Carrots. During this time unknown offender(s) have taken all items.

BREINTON

4th July, report received of criminal damage to fencing in the area of Breinton Springs. Evidence at the scene of overnight camping including litter and burnt fence wire.

BYFORD

8th July. A decorative metal cormorant has been stolen from a private garden in Byford. Distinctive garden ornament.

HOLMER

16th July. Theft of 2x bicycles from communal bike shed on The Furlongs. Both bikes were secured together with bolts and chains.

Moreton on Lugg

Between **21st-23rd July** at around 0700hrs, reported theft of metal from an open cattle shed at a local farm.

DINEDOR

Family were at a fund day in the village where a brown leather wallet was stolen, it was left unattended with a handbag between 1500-1700hrs.

BREINTON

Stones have been thrown and caused damage to the west window of St Michaels church between midday on Sunday 26th and 0900hrs on Tuesday 28th.

MARDEN

29th July. Between 22:00 on the 28th July and 07:30 on 29th July an attempted theft of motor vehicle took place. Vehicle was parked on owners driveway at the front of their property. Victim believes offender(s) used a screwdriver to smash a rear quarter light window. Entry to vehicle was not gained.

WELLINGTON

31st July. 4 fence panels stolen from an unoccupied property overnight between 17:00 and 07:00.

The Safer Neighbourhood Team have recently piloted a property security marking event at Bridge Sollars Community Centre for local residents. The event was advertised by the local parish council. Residents were encouraged to bring along their larger gardening related items such as lawn mowers, trailers, strimmers etc. The items are then permanently marked with the owners postcode which can act as a deterrent to thieves or can assist police when making enquiries and locating the genuine owner.
